TOWER HAMLETS LOVES BUSINESS

With the rich history of the docks, and a population shaped by it, Tower Hamlets is famed for its entrepreneurial spirit.

Canary Wharf is host to two hundred cultural events a year. Its 37 office buildings, 300 shops, cafés and restaurants make it a great place for 120,000 people to work.

Our world-famous markets such as Brick Lane, Spitalfields, Columbia Road, and Petticoat Lane, attract thousands of visitors every day.

We are brimming with successful small and medium-sized

enterprises including the growing digital and creative businesses in Tech City.

And we are the best connected place in London. We combine the capital's highest number of train and tube stations, with City Airport on our doorstep. The Elizabeth Line fast trains connect east to west through Tower Hamlets, providing easy access to Heathrow Airport, Reading and Essex.

All of this means that Tower Hamlets already provides the UK's third highest economic output, and there is much more to come.













THE WORLD'S FAVOURITE BOROUGH

Tower Hamlets is one of the most visted places in the UK for good reason.

World-leading attractions include The Tower of London, Tower Bridge and the Young V&A.

We have over 120 parks. The iconic Victoria Park has been voted in the UK's top 10 parks for 13 years running.

Our events and festivals, such as the London Marathon, Lido and All-Points East festivals, attract international stars and hundreds of thousands of visitors each year.

We are home to part of Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park including being a partner in the new East Bank cultural quarter.

And we are a centre for culture with 22 art galleries, including the Whitechapel Gallery, amazing street art and venues such as Wilton's Music Hall, The Troxy and Rich Mix, make us a cultural destination of choice.

WORLD CLASS LEARNING AND INNOVATION

Queen Mary University of London has more than 30,000 students and is helping to create a life science centre in Whitechapel.

Barts NHS Trust hospitals train more than 4,000 people at any one time for medical careers.

The government's digital service is driving innovation from its headquarters in Whitechapel.

The London Metropolitan University's School of Art, Architecture and Design sits in Whitechapel.

And with London's youngest population, we have the next generation of talent honed by our impressive schools where 96% are rated good or outstanding by Ofsted.

MAKING A WORLD OF DIFFERENCE

Tower Hamlets is a world in one place.

Our residents speak 137 languages, with 43 per cent of residents born in over two hundred different countries. We are the home to London's traditional East End and its cockney dialect.

We are a place where people respect and support one another - 90 per cent of residents say they get on well with one another which is no mean feat in an inner city borough where over 80% of properties are flats.

This all stems from our DNA of social justice and mobility.

Our history has seen residents fight fascism in the Battle of Cable Street and the roots of the Suffragette movement are in Roman Road.

Much of our proud history of immigration and entrepreneurship, comes from The London Docks which were the drop-off point for immigrants to the UK when the docklands were the centre of world trade.
